Be a Good Witness

My dad and I ran a mechanic shop and later I ran my own mechanic business to provide for my family through seven years of college and seminary. During that time I observed that the real picture of the character of a person is revealed when it comes to transactions that involves dollars and cents.

As you may imagine, families going through seminary did not have much money. On many occasions people who needed work on their cars would talk to me and be open and up front with their lack of resources and I would try my best to work with them to keep them going. Unfortunately, there were several other instances where people would have the work done, make no prior arrangements and reveal that they did not have the money to pay for the repairs after I had purchased and installed parts. On some other occasions they would write checks knowing the money was not in the bank.

What bothered me then, as it does now, is that I knew if these people were doing business like that with me, they were also doing business like that with other people. I cringed to think of the poor witness this was for someone who professes Christ as Savior.

The bottom line is this. The way we handle our finances is observed by the people around us. At the bank, credit agencies, building management companies and every other place we transact business there are people there who see how we conduct our lives. We are being a witness in these places for good or ill.

My excitement about Financial Peace University offered by our church beginning in September, is that it will lead you into a position to be a better witness through the way you handle your personal finances. Whether you have little or much, bringing scriptural principles to bear on your stewardship of what you have will strengthen your witness for our Lord Jesus Christ and bring glory to His name.
